

The COO and Chairman of Geophysical Service Incorporated is fuming over a recent Supreme Court ruling that turned down GSI's Access to Information Request to Nalcor. Paul Einarsson says his company

was simply trying to find out if Nalcor had been using its seismic data without permission, but he says the court saw it differently.

He says the decision seemed to hang its hat on another case, between GSI and the C-NLOPB. He says the court glossed over his actual request, which was access Nalcor has had to GSI seismic products.

Einarsson says the judge's ruling takes other cases into account, which have no bearing on the Access to Information case.
